The medium-sized Fabian daughters produce high component milk. Their udder health is better than breed average and they milk out fast.

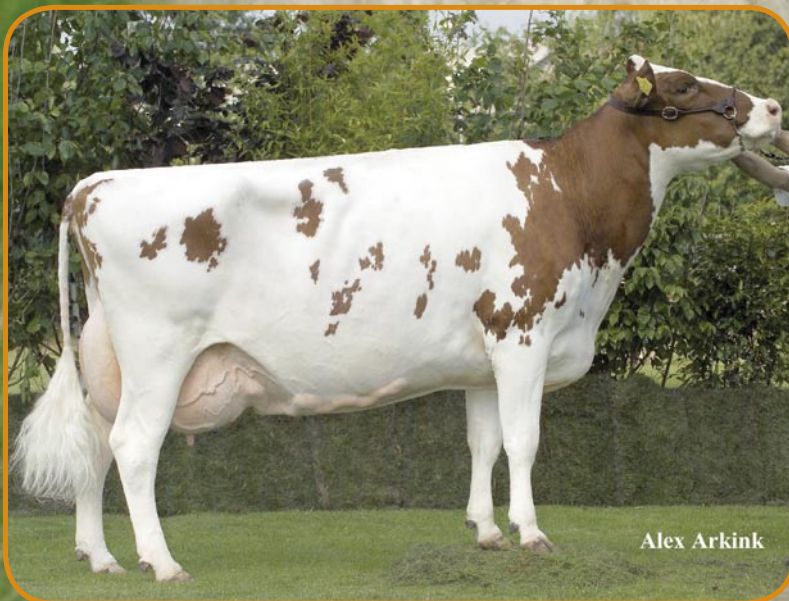
